

Å-Line 2007

The Mail Road Across the Land and Sea

This year's Å-Line route follows the old mail road that was founded by the queen of Sweden, Kristina, in the 16th century.

We will start on Wednesday 11th July from Turku, and finish three days later in Stockholm (14th July) from which we take the ferry back to Turku. We will arrive back at Turku on Sunday morning 15th July.

We will skate around 310 km during those four days. We have a service car with us that serves some drinks and snacks for the skaters, and transports the luggage.

You can join us if you feel that you are able to skate such distances in consecutive days at around 20km / h speed. Also, you need to be able to break. There is room only for 20 people, so be quick if you want to join this great experience ☺!

15.7 Sunday

The ferry arrives at Turku at 7:35 a.m.
